Investment programme November 2016 to March 2017

Issue 9 – 17 February 2017

Listed below are the locks that will be closed during the 2016 to 2017 investment programme. The locks will be closed from the first date listed and re-open the day after the final date.

Canoe portage with care during closure

*Shifford Lock 20 March 2017 to 24 March 2017

Yes

Repairing handrails.

<u>Please note</u>: Re-sheeting lock gates, repairing balance beam and re-fixing rubbing timbers work postponed until the 2017 to 2018 work programme.

King's Lock 1 November 2016 to 3 March 2017

Yes

Re-sheeting lock gates, repairing balance beam and removing silt from travel lines of the lock gates. Head mooring embankment works and additional

revenue moorings.

<u>Please note:</u> there may be opportunities for passage during this period (in 2017) and if so you will be

notified in advance of this.

Clifton Lock 13 February 2017 to 24 February 2017

Yes

Emergency repairs to hydraulic system.

<u>Please note:</u> Work on repairing lock gates postponed until the 2017-18 winter programme which will then

include re-sheeting of the lock gates.

Bell Weir Lock 21 March 2017 to 23 March 2017

Yes

Installation of power and data cables across the upstream lock cut. This work by Southeast Power Engineering is to facilitate the Archimedes screw hydropower system which is under construction.

Repairing and making health and safety improvements to lock gate sluices and seals

Day's Lock

Replacing sluice rod

Goring Lock

Refurbishing lock chamber walls and replacing of worn rubbing timbers

Replacing lock chamber rubbing timbers and re-fixing all grab chains

Old Windsor

Refurbishment and strengthening of the upstream lock cut bridge by Thames Water
