

## **River Thames – River restriction**

## Romney Reach A332 Eton Bridge to Windsor and Eton footbridge Sunday 17 June 2018 – 6am to 9:45am Royal Windsor Triathlon

Directions for navigation and general information during this event:

- At 6am on Sunday 17 June 2018 swimmers will leave A332 Eton Bridge and will swim downstream to Windsor and Eton Footbridge where they will then swim half the course upstream to where they will exit the River.
- Swimmers will hug the Windsor, left bank of the river as they head downstream and will leave a clear navigation channel for boat traffic along the centre of the river. The swimmers will be wearing hi-visibility swim caps and will be escorted by canoe guards.
- All river users are asked to keep a good look out for the swimmers, navigate slowly and with particular caution when in their vicinity and give them a wide berth.

**And Notice is hereby given**, that it is provided by Byelaw 52 of the Thames Navigation Licensing and General Byelaws, 1993 that:

The master of any vessel shall except in an emergency not pass any boat-race regatta public procession or gathering for the launch of a vessel or any other event or function which may cause a crowd to assemble on or by the river nor station his vessel thereon in such a manner as would risk obstructing impeding or interfering with such boat-race regatta procession launching event or function or endangering the safety of persons assembling on the river or preventing or interfering with the maintenance of order thereon.
